AN ARID LANDSCAPE WITH PLANTS THAT WILL TOLERATE THE HARSHEST OF CONDITIONS.

The desert rock garden design at the Petra House features a permeable gravel mulch and rocky arroyo, or bioswale, that blend well with the rammed earth façade. The plant layout is informal. There is added space between plants. This space allows the gravel mulch to stand out and highlights the structure of the plants. Gravel mulches can absorb excessive heat, or if they are light colored, they can lead to excessive glare. Plants are selected for their tolerance to these conditions and to provide natural shade.

At the Petra House the structural forms of agaves, yuccas, and cacti stand out during all seasons. Ornamental grasses, like Mexican feather grass and blue grama grass, have fine-textured foliage. It helps soften and cool the rock garden. Ornamental trees with airy foliage are chosen to provide natural shade.


